

Results on Regional Development of the Projects from 2007-2013 Programming Period

- 100 new jobs created during project execution
- 25,81 km of infrastructure road developed and rehabilitated from a total of 47 Km road network
- 7,38 km of infrastructure system for water and sewage developed and rehabilitated
- 9.249 square meters of green spaces created and modernized
- 1 improved lighting system
- 1 video surveillance system created
- 6,38 meters of bike routes
- 12 km of Pedestrian ways

Major Initiative Aimed at Urban Regeneration

- Developed Chitila as an attraction for investors;
- Improved the quality of life;
- Increased no of new residents by almost 20%;
- Increased local authority's revenues by 1.96 times;
- Increased no of new companies by 5.8 times;
