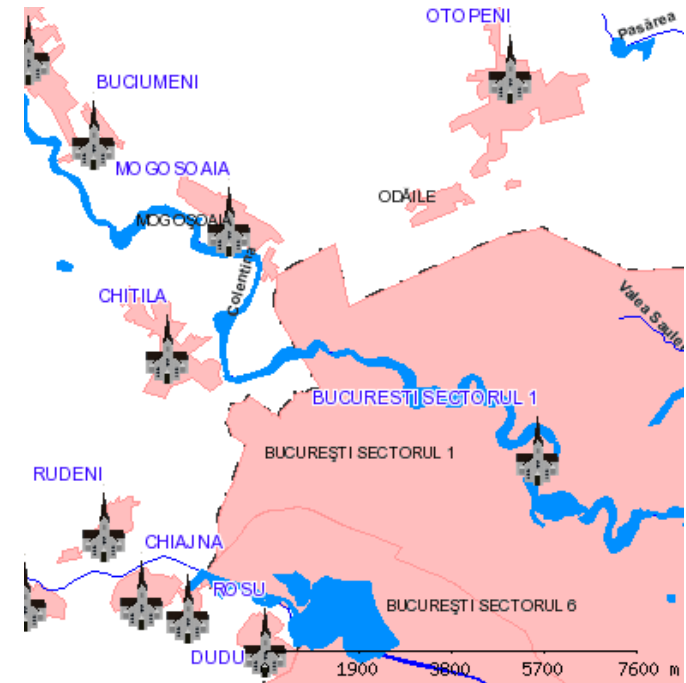

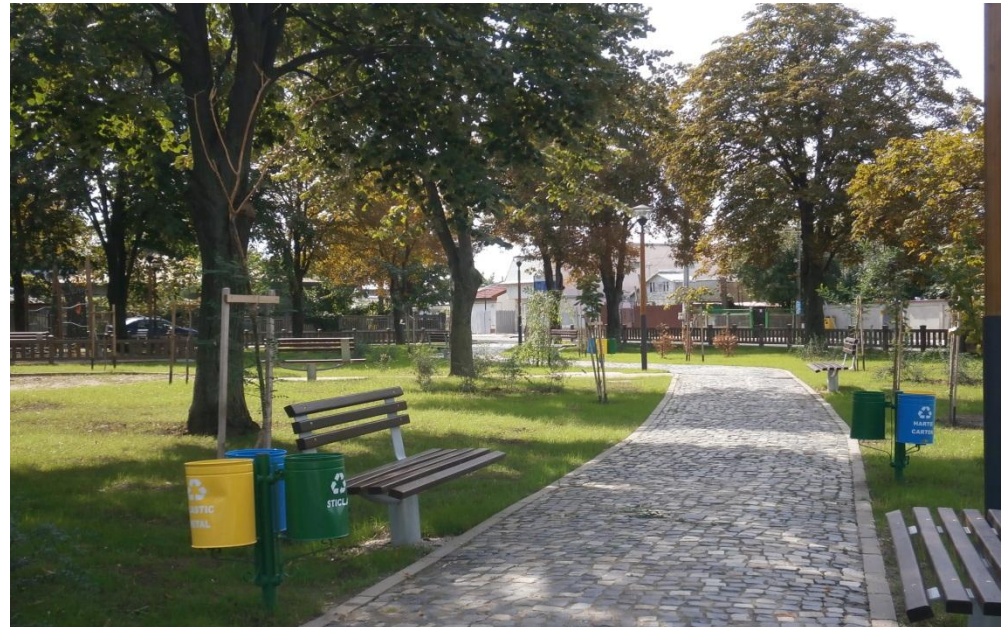

Results on Regional Development

of the Projects from 2007-2013 Programming Period

- ❖ 100 new jobs created during project execution
- ❖ 25,81 km of infrastructure road developed and rehabilitated from a total of 47 Km road network
- ❖ 7,38 km of infrastructure system for water and sewage developed and rehabilitated
- ❖ 9.249 square meters of green spaces created and modernized
- ❖ 1 improved lighting system
- ❖ 1 video surveillance system created
- ❖ 6,38 meters of bike routes
- ❖ 12 km of Pedestrian ways
